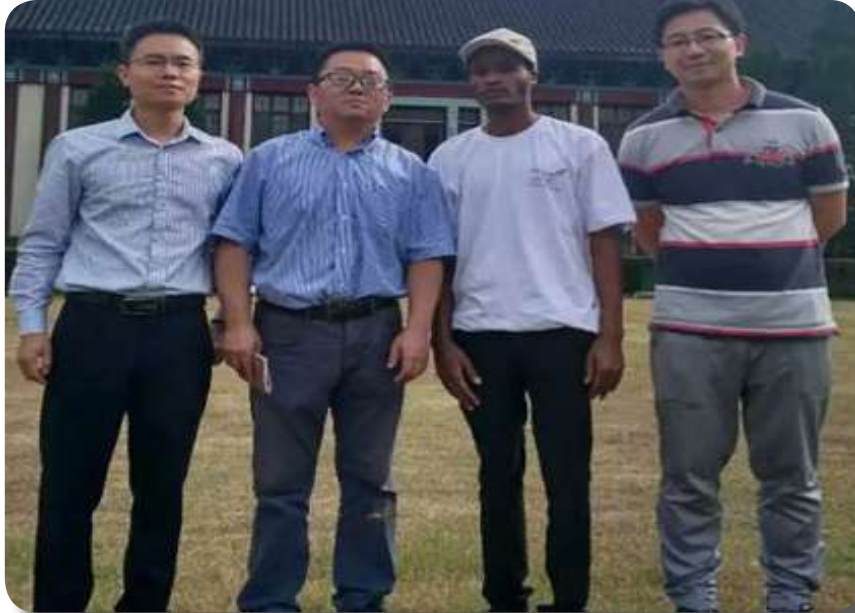

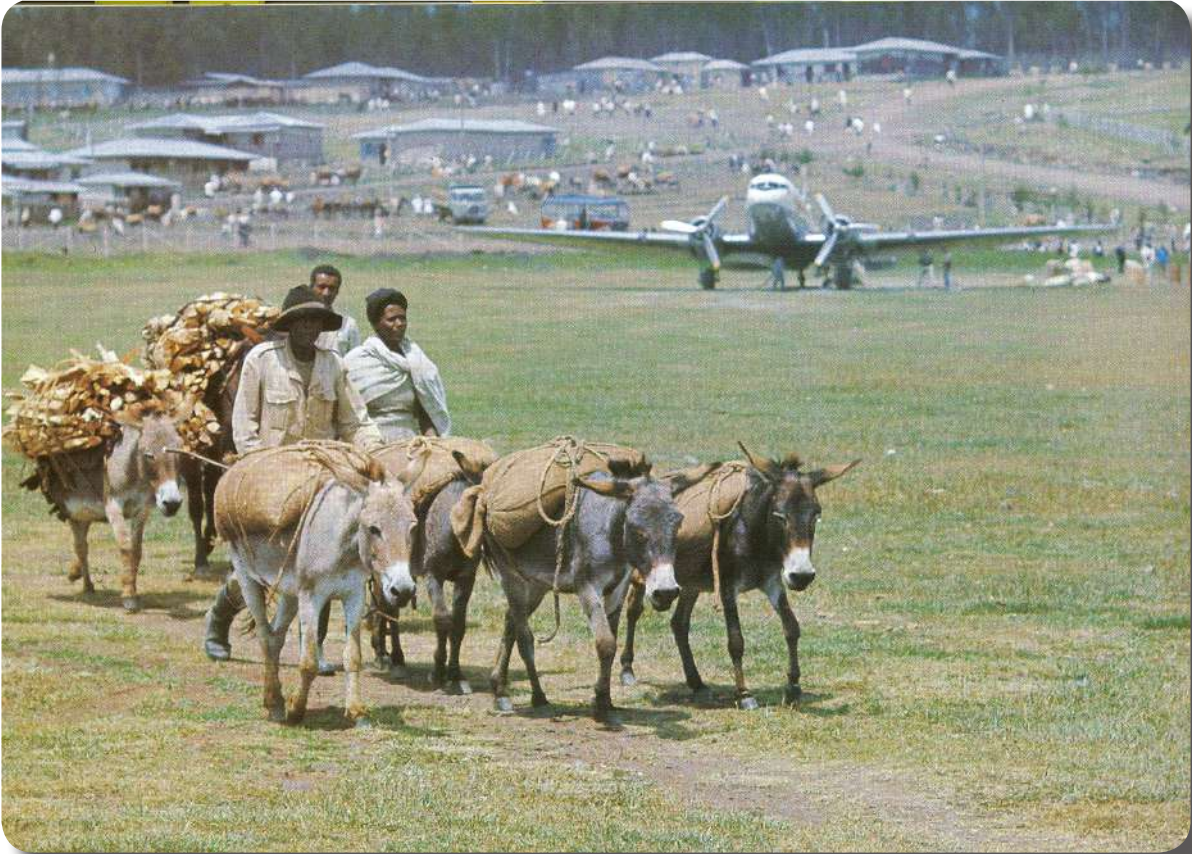
Ethiopian Sponsored New Arts and Culture Advert Launching Ceremony

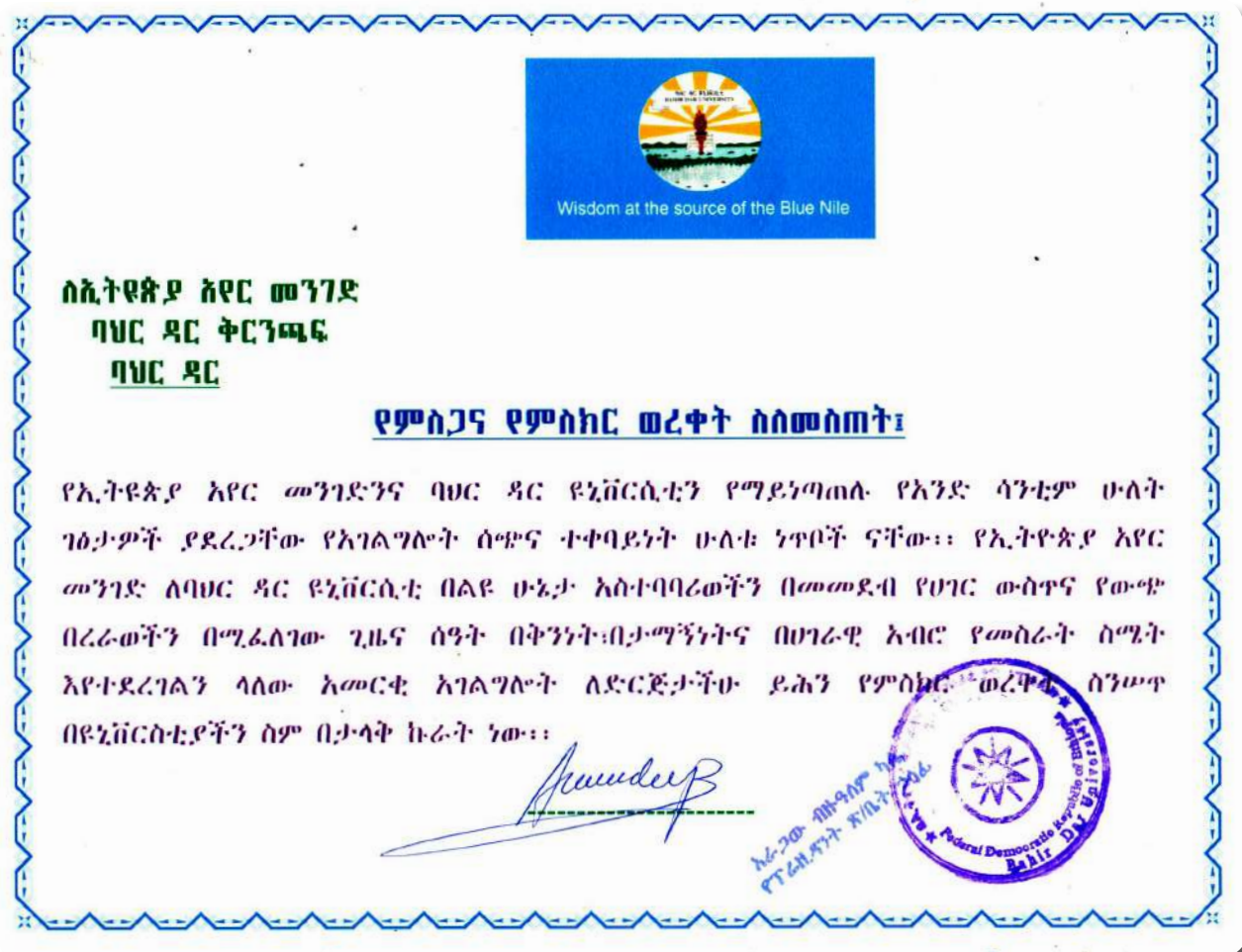


Ethiopian wins Exclusive MICE Product Award

Boeing 787-9 heightens Ethiopian position in Africa's aviation

ADDIS ABABA - The delivery of Africa's first Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner intensifies Ethiopian Airlines' leading position in Africa's aviation industry, Ethiopian Group Chief Commercial Officer Busera Awel says.

Ethiopian Airlines becomes the first African airliner to operate B787-9 and extends its tradition of setting aviation milestones by flying the airplane with the capacity of carrying 315 passengers in the African skies, the Officer tells *The Ethiopian Herald*.

Ethiopian was also Africa's first carrier to fly the technologically advanced B787-8 in August 2012 and similarly introduced B777-200LR, B777-300ER and B777 Freighter.

Busera states that the aircraft puts *Ethiopian* in the highest position in Africa's aviation industry and will enable it to scale up the service it renders for its ever increasing number of customers.

He indicates the delivery manifests the airliner's commitment to extend its pioneering role in African aviation and to give its passengers excellent travel experience.

"The delivery of the aircraft showcases the attention given for the development of the aviation sector in the country and thereby enhancing regional economic integration through safe and modern transport system."

Being the headquarters for the African Union, United Nations Economic Commission of Africa and other regional and international organizations, it is important to connect Addis Ababa with cities in the continent and beyond, the Communication Officer adds.

Busera notes that the aircraft has also a crucial importance to support *Ethiopian* vision of becoming the most competitive and leading aviation group in Africa by 2025.

Stating *Ethiopian* investment in the most advanced aircrafts including Boeing 787-9 is part of its Vision 2025, the Officer expresses the Group's commitment to offer the best possible travel services for its customers.

He says the aircraft, which has additional 45 seats from its predecessor 787-8, has a very enormous capacity and brings unprecedented promotional value for the country in general and the airliner in

Ethiopian Airlines orders four Boeing 777 freighters

Ethiopian Airlines announced an order for four Boeing 777 freighters in a deal valued at more than \$1.3 billion at list prices. The aircraft will be powered by GE90-115B engines.

The transaction includes a new order for two freighters. It also includes two freighters the airline announced as a commitment in June that finalized into a firm order this month.

"This airplane order will provide Ethiopian's Cargo & Logistics business with enhanced cargo capacity and better operating economics as we continue to build one of the largest cargo terminals in the world," Ethiopian Group CEO Tewolde Gebremariam said at the Dubai Air Show.

According to Boeing, this order pushes 777 net orders this year to 57-37 of them for the current-generation 777-providing further support to a smooth production transition to the new 777X.

Ethiopian Cargo operates six 777s and two 757Fs to 39 cargo destinations in Africa, the Middle East, Asia and Europe.

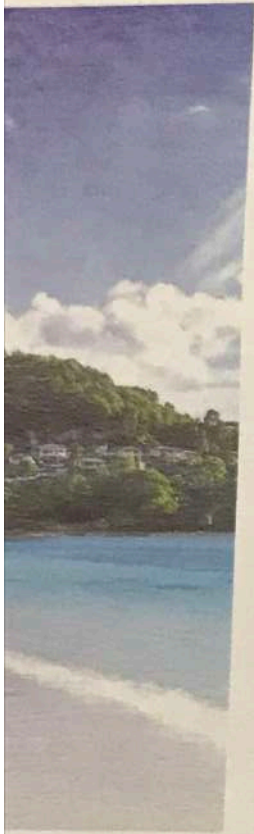

Ethiopian Airlines has become the first airline in Africa to add Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner to its fleet. The aircraft model is one of the most technically advanced, ultra-comfortable, fuel-efficient and environment-friendly in the 787 family that the carrier will operate. Ethiopian Airlines was the first in the world outside Japan to receive and operate the 787-8 back in August 2012.

Both the 787-8 and 787-9 offer superior and unmatched onboard comfort, thanks to their unique features such as the biggest windows in the sky, high ceiling, less noise, distinctive lighting, higher air humidity as well as 20% less fuel. The 787-9 is 20 feet or 6 meters longer than the 787-8 and has more passenger capacity with 315 seats and more cargo space.

Tewelde Gebre Mariam, Group CEO, Ethiopian Airlines, said, “Continuing our legacy of pioneering aviation technology in Africa, we are proud to celebrate yet another first with the introduction of the cutting-edge 787-9 into our young and fast-growing fleet. 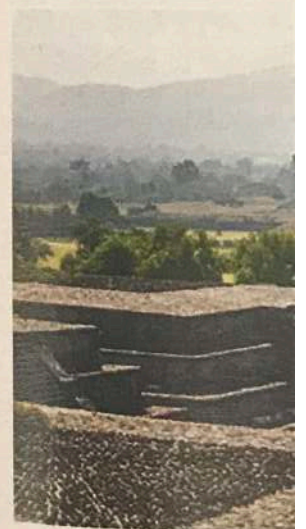

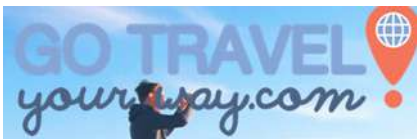

Did you Know that Ethiopia's Waste-to-energy plant is the first in Africa?



For half a century, the Koshe dump site has been the only landfill in Addis Ababa. As the city has expanded, the landfill – which used to lie on the outskirts of the Ethiopian capital – has become part of the urban landscape, sprawling over an area the size of 36 football pitches and attracting hundreds of waste pickers who make their living from salvaged trash. Earlier this year, a landslide on the dump site killed 114 people, prompting the government to declare three days of mourning.

But a new waste-to-energy plant is set to transform the site and revolutionize the entire city's approach to dealing with waste. The plant, which is due to begin operating in January, will incinerate 1,400 tons of waste every day – that's roughly 80 per cent of the city's rubbish – all while supplying Addis with 30 per cent of its household electricity needs and meeting European standards on air emissions.

The facility, which is the result of a partnership between the Government of Ethiopia and a consortium of international companies, is the first of its kind in Africa.

"The Reppie project is just one component of Ethiopia's broader strategy to address pollution and embrace renewable energy across all sectors of the economy," said Zerubabel Getachew, Ethiopia's deputy permanent representative to the United Nations in Nairobi. "We hope that Reppie will serve as a model for other countries in the region, and around the world."
